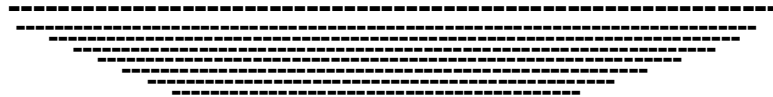

□ Surgical Experience

After I obtained my qualification in general surgery I worked for one year as a specialist assistant in the department of general surgery in Jordan University hospital. I gained more experience as I performed most of the common general surgical operations unsupervised.

At Al-Khalidi medical center and later at the kingdom hospital I had the opportunity to perform all common general surgical procedures and to participate in many plastic, pediatrics cardiothoracic and vascular procedures.

At Tawam hospital , in the first two years, I was involved in the management of wide spectrum of general surgical cases and performed most of the general surgical procedures including basic laparoscopic procedures, beside the fact that I had the opportunity to be involved in the management of both elective and emergency vascular cases , I performed most of the basic vascular procedures (insertion of different types of permanent central venous lines, arterial anastomosis, varicose veins surgery, construction of primary atreio-venous fistulas for end stage renal failure patients on dialysis, and assisted in major vascular procedures. Later I was involved in the management of patients requiring advanced hepatobiliary, upper gastrointestinal and colorectal care (including liver resection, surgery for CBD lesions, Whipple's procedure, gastric resection and colorectal resection including total proctocolectomy with pouch anastomosis for ulcerative colitis, and total mesorectal excision for rectal carcinoma.

From June 2007 to July 2009, during my fellowship, at the Gastrointestinal and Laparoscopic Surgery Unit in St Vincent's hospital, NSW, I actively participated and did many esophageogastric, pancreatic and hepatobiliary procedures, I also get involved and performed advanced laparoscopic surgical procedures like laparoscopic total extra peritoneal inguinal hernia repair, cholecystectomy with CBD exploration, patching of perforated peptic ulcer, gastric banding, sleeve gastrectomy, Nissen fundoplication, pancreatic pseudocysto-gastrostomy, gastrectomy, distal pancreatectomy and splenectomy, beside esophagectomy with thoracoscopic mobilization of esophagus.
